SECTION MEETING MINUTES

August 20, 2004

Present: Glenn and Daniel Feveryear, Larry Gerlach, Rick Hackman, Dale Greene, George and Mark Beever.

The President called the meeting to order at 7:25PM and called for the committee reports:
